## Jeremy's memorial

### explanation of unveiling tradition

Within the first year after the passing of a loved one, mourners and their family gather at the gravesite for a ceremony called the unveiling, the placing of the tombstone. At this event, a grave marker is put into place and the monument is formally dedicated. *we are creating a virtual gravesite ...* It is a spiritual time for the family to comfort each other and remember their loved one. *an opportunity for everyone to participate in remembering Jeremy ...* Another custom that is frequently part of the unveiling is placing stones or pebbles on the monument. This custom has many origins and interpretations, but in its simplest explanation, it is a clear representation and reminder that the family was at the gravesite. *signing the guestbook can be our virtual pebbles* The unveiling also allows the bereaved family members to honor and to recall the memory of their departed. It is a chance to continue to reflect upon the significance of that person's life, his or her accomplishments, and the people who were important. In a sense, through the unveiling, the memory of a person's life is etched permanently into the collective memory of the Jewish community.

### explanation of ecorial app and website links

*From Login screen:* Ecorial@ is the leading new way to memorialize and honor a loved one as they Rest in Nature@. When scattering ashes on land or in the water, burying remains at a special place, or planting ashes with a tree, use the Ecorial@ App to "mark the spot" by recording the exact GPS coordinates plus the time and date of the event. You can also upload photos and videos of your loved one's forever resting place and create a beautiful interactive obituary with ease. This special location can be found forever on the Memory Map@ and shared with family, friends, and, if you choose, the world to see!

*We chose to bury ashes discretely in places Jeremy loved, to unite his material existence with his spiritual experience of these places, rather than a cemetery no one will visit.*

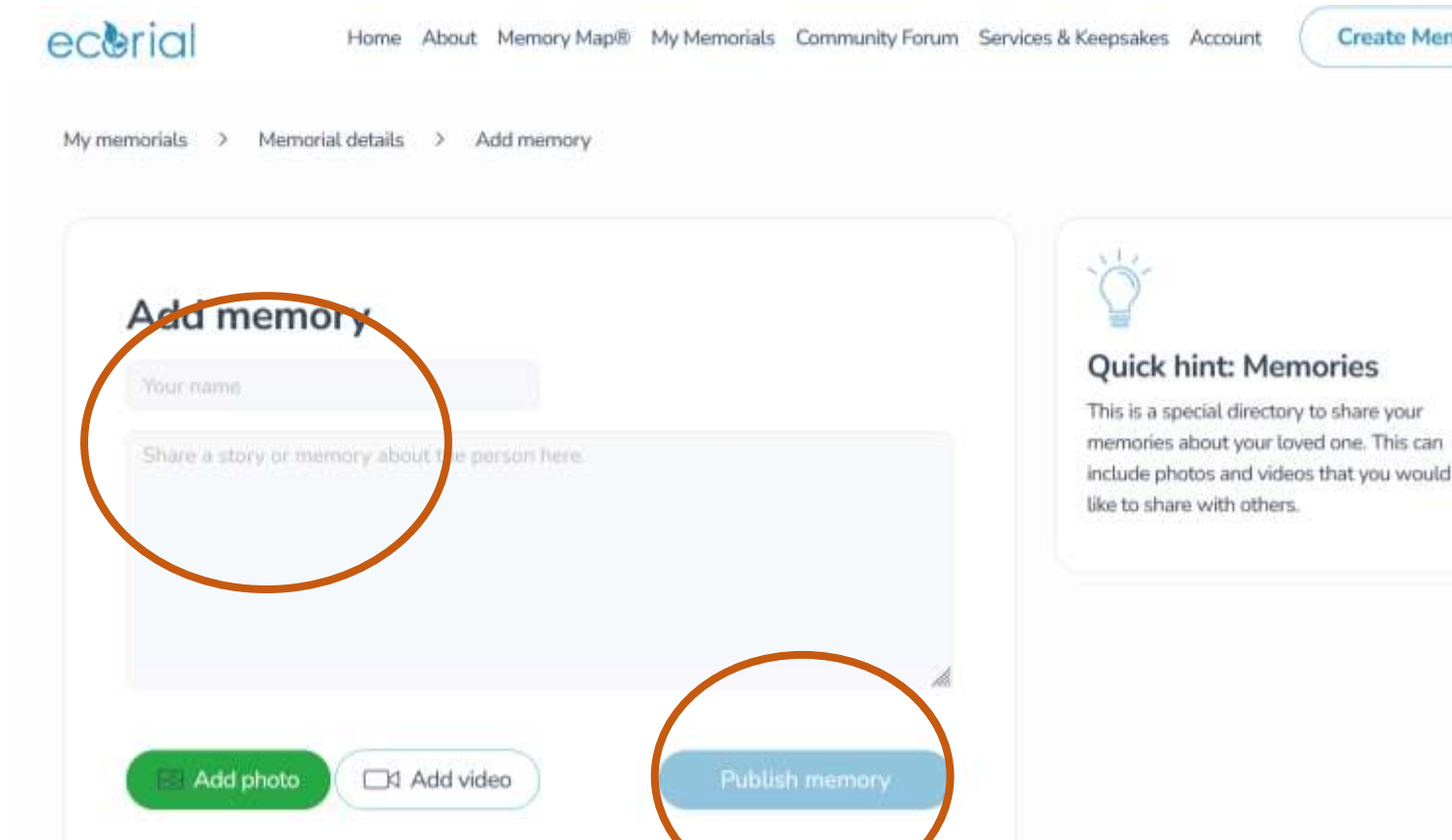

view resting places SCROLL using > or < to see each place

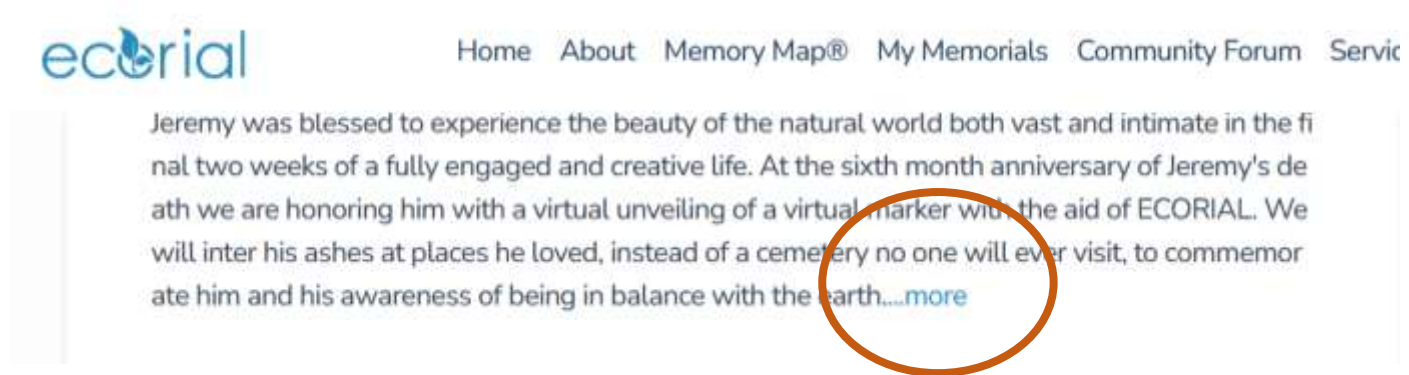
CLICK **open details** SCROLL DOWN to see place photos and description
